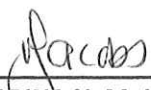

- V. To promote the children's development on all levels of their human existence by supporting their participation in the activities of the surrounding communities, churches, schools, sport and other activities;
- VI. To include the community in the promotion of the care and development of the children through integrated services and programs.;
- VII. To network with other organizations through establishment, coordination and development of such networks;
- VIII. To work towards the re-instatement of each child to the care of his/her biological parents/family; and
- IX. To offer- to the extent to which Huis Maerua's relevant committed involvement and available help is concerned – therapeutic and other statutory social work services to children reported to be in a situation of alleged need of care, substitute care such as foster placements and children available for adoption.
